MATH ACTIVITIES TO BE DONE CLASS XII (2024 - 25)

Activity 1: To verify that the relation R in the set L of all lines in a plane, defined by $R = \{(I, m): I \perp m\}$ is symmetric but neither reflexive nor transitive.

Activity 2: To verify that the relation R in the set L of all lines in a plane, defined by $R = \{(I, m): I \mid | m\}$ is an equivalence relation.

Activity 3: To demonstrate a function which is not one-one but is onto.

Activity 4: To demonstrate a function which is one-one but not onto.

Activity 5: To draw the graph of $\sin -1 x$, using the graph of $\sin x$ and demonstrate the concept of mirror reflection (about the line y = x).

Activity 6: To explore the principal value of the function **sin-1** *x* using a unit circle.

Activity 7: To sketch the graphs of a x and loga x, a > 0, $a \ne 1$ and to examine that they are mirror images of each other. Activity 8: To establish a relationship between common logarithm (to the base 10) and natural logarithm (to the base e) of the number x.

Activity 9: To find analytically the limit of a function f(x) at x = c and also to check the continuity of the function at that point.

Activity 10: To verify that for a function f to be continuous at given point x0, $\Delta y = |f(x0+\Delta x)-f(x0)|$ is arbitrarily small provided. Δx is sufficiently small.
